The Dancenter North Boys Scholarship Program is a tuition-free program for boys ages 6-18. It is designed to enhance athletic skills, flexibility, self-discipline, musicality, mental focus, creativity, and strength. This program requires a one-year commitment to dance training with DCN.

Acceptance into the program is by application. No prior dance training is required. If accepted, scholarship recipients will be required to register for Boys Dance Fusion and one Ballet class. Reduced tuition will be considered if the student chooses not to enroll in either of these classes. Boys are also encouraged to register for classes in any other disciplines of their choosing, including Jazz, Tap, Hip-Hop, Modern, Broadway, and Triple Threat.

Scholarship recipients are allowed three absences per semester. Excessive absences will lead to dismissal from the program. New students with prior dance experience should attend our free placement classes for a proper evaluation before the Fall Session begins.
