Défilé Final Notes & Theatre Arrival Times

Saturday, May 25th, 2019 at 1:00 pm

- A stage rehearsal will be held on the same day prior to the concert. Students must **arrive promptly** at the time listed below for their class (default to the earliest arrival time if your child is in multiple classes). Please wait to check in with staff until your specific class arrival time.
- **Only one parent** may accompany their student to check in. Please enter at the south circle entrance just around the corner from the main doors of the theatre. There will be directional signs posted for your convenience.
- You will be greeted by Dancenter North staff and shown the proper line for your child to be given an ID band and a parent ID tag.
- Parents will leave their child with DCN staff after check in is complete. Your child will be escorted backstage by staff for their onstage rehearsal.
- **Students must arrive with costume on and hair done (and optional makeup)... ready to go!** There is no time or place to do this at the theatre. Please help your child to change into his/her dance shoes at the check in point so that you may take the street shoes with you and any additional clothing that may have been worn to the theatre. **Do not leave anything with your child** (no dance bags, street shoes, extra clothing, water bottles, etc).
- **Students should arrive in the first costume they are presented in for the concert.** Please reference the order of show below, which is the same as the order of arrival.
- If your student is in more than one class presentation during this program, students will not change costumes for rehearsal time onstage. Your child's extra costumes, including shoes, accessories, etc. should be placed in a **LARGE, CLEAR ZIPLOC BAG ON A HANGER with a "Change of Costume" form filled out and placed inside the bag with the writing facing out.** Forms are available online on our Défilé page or in the office. If your child has more than one costume change, you must use a **separate bag and form for each costume.**
- Your children will be happier and more eager to perform if they arrive on time and ready to go with the rest of their class. **Please help set your child up for success by arriving at the time requested!**
- Parents and family attending the concert (including the parent who drops off the student for check in) must enter the building through the main doors and wait in the lobby.
- The doors to the theatre will open approximately 10 minutes prior to the performance.

The following arrival chart is the order in which classes will appear in the concert. There are DCN Company performance pieces placed appropriately between selected classes in order to allow students plenty of time to change costumes.

COSTUME & ACCESSORIES: All Pre-Ballet students must wear the **required class attire for the concert.** Girls should be in a light pink leotard (any style; **no skirt attached**) with light pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Boys should be in a white t-shirt, black shorts, and black ballet shoes. Hair should be pulled back neatly in a bun (or secured away from the face for short hair). Students should not wear any accessory in their hair other than the one distributed by the teacher. Parents of female Ballet students will also need to purchase the required pink tutu at Avenue 21 Dancewear (it is acceptable to wear a Défilé-specific pink tutu purchased from Avenue 21 in previous years). Tap and Hip-Hop students should be in classroom dress code, unless otherwise instructed by Ms. Jillian. All accessories will be distributed by your teachers in the last two weeks of classes. **Keep the accessory in a safe place, as there are absolutely no extras!** If needed, teachers will provide specific instructions as to how the accessory should be worn.

STUDENT DISMISSAL: At the conclusion of the performance, the students will exit the auditorium. Parents must remain seated until their child's class is announced over the P.A. system. These announcements can only be heard in the auditorium. Upon this announcement, only the parent with the ID tag will be allowed to pick up their child. Because of security issues and disruption of the performance, **parents will not be allowed to take their children until the end of the performance.**

PHOTOGRAPHS: *Studio West Photography* will once again be taking class & individual pictures of the performers at the theatre on the day of the concert. Order forms will be available online on our Défilé page in early May.

CONGRATULATORY GIFTS: *Avenue 21 Dancewear* will be in the lobby for all concerts with a variety of congratulatory gifts & flowers available for purchase.

DVD SALES: Professional videographer, Laura Lockwood, will make DVDs of each concert. The order form will be available online on our Défilé page in early May. For those wishing to bring in personal video cameras, please be considerate of those around you in the auditorium.
