# DÉFILÉ – GREEN CONCERT

## Sunday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 @ 6:15 pm

### WHAT IS DÉFILÉ?

We like to think of Défilé as a “concert-graduation”. It gives our students an opportunity to perform on the stage in a comfortable situation without hours of rehearsal and tons of pressure. Parents can witness the progress their student has made over the year. Dancenter North borrowed this concept from the Paris Opera Ballet School who present a Défilé (translation: *parade*) each year at the end of their season.

### SO, IT ISN'T A RECITAL?

No. It isn't a big spectacle with fancy costumes and sets.

### WHEN IS MY DÉFILÉ?

The **GREEN** concert will be presented on **Sunday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 6:15 pm.**

### WHERE IS DÉFILÉ HELD?

We hold our performances at the Carmel High School Auditorium located at One Carmel Parkway, Mundelein, Illinois 60060.

### WHO PARTICIPATES?

All students in technique classes starting with our **Intro to Pre-Ballet** classes up through our graduating **8th graders** participate in Défilé. Elective classes (such as Leaps & Turns, Foot & Ankle Conditioning, etc.) are not presented in Défilé. Mommy & Me students, High School students, & Adult students do not participate either.

### HOW MUCH REHEARSAL CAN WE EXPECT?

Dancenter North believes that class time should be spent developing technique. For that reason, practice for Défilé is kept at a minimum and rehearsed only during a small fraction of class time.

### WHAT IF MY STUDENT IS IN MORE THAN ONE CLASS IN A PARTICULAR DISCIPLINE?

A student may only participate with one class per discipline. They will, of course, participate in all registered disciplines (*ie. a student registered in Ballet 3A on Tuesday and Ballet 3A on Saturday will perform with only one of those registered Ballet classes*). Class Distribution Lists will be posted online and at the studio. Students registered for multiple classes within one discipline can find the class with which they will be presented when the lists are posted mid-February.

### WHAT IS THE FEE FOR THAT I PAID AT REGISTRATION TIME?

The fee (which was included with Spring semester tuition) pays for the supplement to the student's apparel for the occasion. Our staff works to find an appropriate accessory for each class and each student. It is organized, packaged and delivered during your class 1-2 weeks prior to the concert.

### WHAT SORT OF COSTUMING/APPAREL MUST WE ALSO SUPPLY?

Female Ballet students will be required to wear their classroom attire as listed on our class schedule. An assigned Ballet tutu will also be required. Purchasing information for tutus will be made available in future communication. Male Ballet students will be required to wear their classroom uniform of black shorts, a white t-shirt, white socks, & black ballet shoes. All Ballet students will also receive a supplemental accessory for the concert. Modern students will receive instruction from teachers regarding their attire. Your child's teacher will supplement his/her attire with an accessory.

### HOW LONG DOES THE CONCERT LAST?

You can expect your concert to last approximately 1½ hours.

### HOW MUCH ARE TICKETS AND HOW DO WE PURCHASE THEM?

A ticket lottery will be held for all performances. Tickets are \$13.00 and all seats are reserved. Look for further information in the next informational letter, which will be posted in the Défilé section of our website at [www.dancenter-north.com](http://www.dancenter-north.com).

### WHY DO WE HAVE TO PAY FOR A TICKET?

Ticket sales help to defray the expenses such as theatre rental, janitorial workers, insurance, printing, office expenses, rental of lighting and sound equipment, technical personnel for the performances, backdrop and the numerous personnel needed to make the day run smoothly.

### WHAT IF OUR SCHEDULE CHANGES AND WE NEED TO CHANGE TO A DIFFERENT CLASS?

Any student who wishes to make changes to their Spring class schedule must do so by **SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020**. Any changes made after this date will mean that the student will not be able to participate with their new class in the Défilé performance.

### WHAT IF OUR CHILD IS NOT INTERESTED OR IS UNAVAILABLE TO PERFORM?

If your child chooses not to participate in this year's Défilé for personal reasons, please send your regrets via email to [info@dancercenter-north.com](mailto:info@dancercenter-north.com) with "Défilé Regret" in the subject line. Instructors need to know if your student will not participate in this program, as it affects choreography. **Regrets must be sent no later than SAT, FEB 1<sup>st</sup> ONLY IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT GOING TO PARTICIPATE.** Your decision to not participate is irreversible. Défilé fees are nonrefundable, regardless of participation.
