Please read all instructions carefully. Défilé is a fun and exciting experience for all involved. Your attention to detail helps to ensure smooth operations for everyone, particularly our young performers.

CHECKING IN

- A rehearsal will be held immediately before the performance to help students feel comfortable & ready to present their pieces! **Students must arrive promptly at the time listed on page 2 of this note.** If your child is presented in multiple classes, default to the earliest check-in time.
- **Only one parent may accompany their student at check-in.** Please drive around the left side of Carmel High School as you enter the campus and park in the back lot (do not park along the curb). Enter the school through the side doors. There will be "**STUDENT ENTRY**" signs to guide you. You will be greeted by staff and shown where to check in.
- **Parents must exit the building once their child is checked in.** Class helpers & teachers will escort students backstage.
- Your child will be happier and more eager to perform when you are **prepared and on time.** Please help set up your child for success by arriving at the time requested.
- **Audience members will be allowed to enter the lobby of the theatre no sooner than 20 minutes prior to each performance.** All seats are reserved, so there is no need to arrive early.
- We anticipate a 60-minute performance. **All attendees must be ticket-holders, regardless of age.** Tickets will be available for purchase at the studio through May 19th and then in the lobby of the theatre at Carmel HS (until sold out).

COSTUMES & ACCESSORIES

- **Students' costumes for Défilé are their class uniforms.** Be sure your child is wearing the correct color leotard for her Ballet class! We have ordered accessories by teachers' requests, which coordinate with the theme of each piece. Your child will receive his/her accessory during class within the two weeks leading up to Défilé. Please keep your accessories safe! There are no extras and we will not be able to replace lost or damaged items before the concert. Labeling your child's items is always a good idea.
- **Female Ballet students need to purchase a class-assigned tutu from our dancewear boutique, *The Avenue*.**
- All performers should have their hair secured up & away from their face for the concert (female Ballet students must have their hair wrapped securely in a bun). Students performing with multiple classes will not change hairstyles between pieces. If you have any questions about costuming, how to wear an accessory, hairstyles, etc., please call the office or reach out to your child's teacher. We're happy to help!
- **Students must arrive READY TO DANCE...** with their first costume and dance shoes on, hair done, and ready to go! There is no time or place to do so at check-in. Please help your child change into his/her dance shoes in the lobby. Do not leave street shoes with them.
- Classes will be presented in the order listed on page 2 of this note. If your student is in multiple classes, complete a **COSTUME CHANGE FORM**. Forms are available at the studio & on the website in the Défilé tab. Instructions for how to prepare costume changes are on the form. Do NOT wait to fill this out until you check-in on concert day. Doing so delays the check-in process and may cause your child to miss his/her rehearsal on stage.
- **STUDENTS MAY NOT TAKE ANYTHING BACKSTAGE**. No street shoes, extra clothing, water bottles, dance bags, phones, or any extra materials are allowed. Emergency medical supplies such as EpiPens, inhalers, etc. should be labeled in a bag and given directly to a staff member at check-in and promptly retrieved at dismissal.

DISMISSAL

- **At the conclusion of the concert, all audience members must remain seated.** Students will be paraded out of the theatre as you congratulate them on their accomplishments. Students will be dismissed by class and you will be given directions on where to meet them. **Do not leave your seat until your child's class is announced.** Costume change bags will be waiting for you to pick up on your way out. We kindly ask all families to exit the theatre quickly after dismissal as we prepare for the next concert. You are welcome to stay on the outdoor lawn for pictures with your dancer!

PHOTOGRAPHY, GIFTS

- **Professional Photographers & Videographers** will be at all concerts. Please watch for more information regarding ordering.

Check-in times should be strictly observed (no earlier, no later). Remember to default to your child's earliest check-in time if they are in multiple classes.
